Whitetail Deer, Black Bear and Waterfowl

Suggested Gear List for Bear Hunt

- * **Bow**
- * **Arrows (1 Dozen)**
- * **Broadheads** & field points
- * **Release** & backup
- Rifle and Ammo**
- Daypack
- Rubber boots (Knee Hi)
- Camp Shoes/Slippers
- Camouflage suit and/or Camo Scent-Lok suit
- Camo hat
- Camo head net
- Camo gloves
- Rain Gear/Tree umbrella
- Insect headnet
- Socks
- Shirts
- Jeans
- Belt
- Underwear
- Long Underwear (no cotton)
- Warm sweater or jacket
- Medium weight jacket
- Gloves or mittens (wool or waterproof)
- Thermocell Unit (works great!)
or Insect repellent (w/Deet)
- Plastic Trash bags/Zip lock bags
- Camera - Plenty of Film or memory cards
- Video camera/extra tapes/batteries
- Binoculars (small pair is fine)
- Range Finder (bowhunters)
- Personal hygiene gear (Tooth brush, soap etc.)
- Wash cloth and towel
- Knife
- Lighter or waterproof matches
- Compass
- Sunglasses
- Small quality flashlight (headlamps work great)
- Extra batteries
- Baby wipes
- Sun tan lotion
- Good book or magazines
- Duct tape or clear packing tape
- Rope

- Hangers/hooks - for bow/rifle/gear in tree
- Extra duffle bag or breathable grain sack
(bringing hide/skull home)
- Drivers license (for I.D.)
- Passport
- Copy of serial number of gun, make etc.
- Money (Cash) for balance of hunt, tips, etc.
- Credit Card - alcohol, gifts, purchases etc.
- Walkie talkie

** Suggestion:

To remain as scent free as possible wash all clothing in scent free detergent prior to trip and store in plastic bags. Bear have unbelievable sense of smell.

** Luggage tags inside and outside of bags.

** Thermocell Unit

(HIGHLY recommended vs. insect repellent)
They work incredibly well and don't stink! Bugs have never been a problem - but you never know.

Travel bags if flying

- 1 duffle bag
- 1 rifle case - travel/hard case
- 1 carry on (day pack)

Note:

- No sharp objects in carry on or possession.
- Place all/any knives in duffle or gun case.
- 50lb weight limit on bags for most airlines. Distribute some weight in gun/bow case. I like to place breakable items like binocs, range finder etc. in the hard case.
- Be sure all luggage is clearly marked with clearly labeled name tags, name address, etc.

- Cell phones DO work in camp AND out in the field.
- No sleeping bags necessary - beds, pillows, blankets supplied.
