Whitetail Deer, Black Bear and Waterfowl

Suggested Gear List for Deer Hunt

Rifle (dead on @ 200 yds.)
Ammunition
Daypack
Hunting boots
Camp Shoes/Slippers (cros work great)
Wool Camouflage suit
Hunter Orange
(vest = min. 400 sq. in. - can be camo orange)
Hat (must be solid orange hat)
Gloves
Warm Pants (preferably wool or polar fleece)
Rain Gear
Socks
Shirts
Jeans
Belt
Underwear
Sweats
Fleece loungewear
Long Underwear
Warm sweaters or shirts
Heavy weight/warm jacket
Gloves/Mittens (wool/waterproof)
Camera
Binoculars
Rangefinder (shots 10-1,000 yards?)
Personal hygiene gear (Tooth brush, soap etc.)
Towel and washcloth
Sunglasses/glasses
Small quality flashlight (headlamps work great)
Extra batteries
Baby wipes
Good book or magazines
Drivers license (for I.D.)
Passport

Neck gaiter
Knit hat
Glove liners
Seat cushion/warmer (long sits)
Heat packs (foot and hand warmers)
Shooting sticks
Rattling horns
Money/Cash for balance of hunt, tips and lic./tags in camp.
2 Thermos' - 1 for soup/1 for coffee
Walkie talkie?

**** Suggestion:**

To remain as scent free as possible wash all clothing in scent free detergent prior to trip and store in plastic bags.

** Luggage tags inside and outside of bags.

Travel bags if flying

1 duffle bag
1 rifle case - travel/hard case
1 carry on (day pack)

Note:

- No sharp objects in carry on or possession.
 - Place all/any knives in duffle or gun case.
 - 50lb weight limit on bags for most airlines. Distribute some weight in gun/bow case. I like to place breakable items like binocs, range finder etc. in the hard case.
 - Be sure all luggage is clearly marked with clearly labeled name tags, name address, etc.

- Cell phones DO work in camp AND out in the field.
 - No sleeping bags necessary - beds, pillows, blankets supplied.
